## Scope & Sequence

### Older One Year Olds

(Gospel Light's Baby Beginnings, *I Love to Look!*)

\*Read books throughout and verbalize to the children about what you, or they, are doing with the items.

\*\*Art can be included in the various themes throughout the year: crayons, chalk, finger paint, etc.

\*\*\*Say the Bible verse to each child several times throughout the month.

\*\*\*\*On the attached sheet, incorporate Language, Math, and Letter/Writing activities within the theme each month.

September	I See God's Love at Church	<p>"I like to come to church." (See Psalm 122:1)</p> <hr/> <p>Thank you, God, for the people at my church who love and care for me.</p>	Read story and show picture card about Jesus' parents taking Him to church.	Build church house and road with blocks. Drive toy care to church and talk about why it's fun to go to church.
October	Jesus Loves Children	<p>"Jesus loves the children." (See Mark 10:16)</p> <hr/> <p>Thank you, Jesus, for loving (child's name)!</p>	Read story and show picture card about how Jesus loved the children.	Pretend to feed and rock the doll or stuffed animal. Talk about how God cares for you.
November	God Give Me Food	<p>"God gives us food." (See Genesis 1:29)</p> <hr/> <p>Thank you, God, for my food!</p>	Read story and show picture card about how Jesus cooked some fish and bread for His friends.	Set out plate and small snack such as crackers. Talk about how God provides food for us.
December	Jesus Was a Baby	<p>"His name is Jesus." (See Luke 1:31)</p> <hr/> <p>Thank you, God, for baby Jesus.</p>	Read story and show picture card about how Mary and Joseph cared for baby Jesus. They were so glad He was born.	Build a barn from blocks and add people and animals. Talk about how Jesus was born in a barn.
January	God Helps Me to Grow	<p>"God made us." (See Malachi 2:10)</p> <hr/> <p>Thank you, God, for helping me to grow so big.</p>	Read story and show picture card about how Jesus grew from a baby to a big kid.	Give each child a doll. Make the doll walk and talk. Talk about the doll growing bigger and bigger.
February	My Family Loves Me	<p>"God gives us family." (See Psalm 68:6)</p> <hr/> <p>Thank you, God, for my family. Thank you for helping me learn about You</p>	Read story and show picture card about Timothy and how his family loved and cared for him.	Give children family figures to play with and talk about how our families take care of us.
March	Jesus Loves Me	<p>"Jesus loves us." (See Revelation 1:5)</p> <hr/> <p>Thank you, God, for my family. Thank you for helping me learn about You.</p>	Read story and show picture card about how Zacchaeus climbed at tree so he could see Jesus.	Collect a variety of nature items (leaves, bark, flowers). Talk about how Zacchaeus climbed up a tree to see Jesus.

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<b>April</b>	God Makes Growing Things	<p>“God made everything.” (See Genesis 1:1)</p> <hr/> <p>Thank you, God, for making things grow.</p>	Read story and show picture card about how God made the grass, flowers, trees, dogs, cats, pigs, cows, and babies.	Give the child one animal at a time and talk the name of the animal and the sound it makes. Then give them a doll. What sound does a baby make? Talk about how God makes animals and us grow.
<b>May</b>	People at Church Help Me	<p>“God gives people to help me.”</p> <hr/> <p>Thank you, Jesus, for people who love us.</p>	Read story and show picture card about how Jesus walked with his friends. Their feet got dirty and because He loved them so much, He washed their feet.	Have children remove their shoes and walk on various pieces of textured fabric. Talk about how Jesus helped His friends wash their feet
