Scope & Sequence

Younger One Year Olds

(Bible verse and prayer from Gospel Light's Baby Beginnings, *I Love to Look!*)

Each of these Discovery Themes will support and enhance brain development and establish a solid foundation for early learning. The children will develop skills in areas of large and fine motor, cognitive, language, social and emotional, self-help/adaptive, and general knowledge.

*Read books throughout and verbalize to the children about the items and what you, or they, are doing with the items.

**Art can be included in the various themes throughout the year: crayons, chalk, finger paint, etc.

***Say the Bible verse to each child several times throughout the month.

****On the attached sheet, incorporate Language, Math, and Letter/Writing activities within your Discovery Theme each month.

January	Discovery materials	Scarfs (peek-a-boo, hiding items, waving), nesting boxes, pounding toys, pop-up toys, feely bag, smell jars, boxes to fill and dump, textured items	<p>"God made us." (See Malachi 2:10)</p> <hr/> <p>Thank you, God, for helping me to grow so big.</p>
February	Dolls/Stuffed Animals/Storytelling materials	Cloth dolls, washable baby dolls, baby dolls with hair, bottles, stuffed animals, puppets	<p>"God gives us family." (See Psalm 68:6)</p> <hr/> <p>Thank you, God, for my family. Thank you for helping me learn about You</p>
