The first thing that jumps out is the fact that Philip was ready to hear from the Lord and so the Lord spoke to Philip. Take a moment to sit and listen for the Lord's voice. 9 Explain It Acts 8:30-32	10 The second thing that jumps out is Philip's obedience. He didn't question God. He went in faith that God had something important for him to accomplish. 30 Explain It Acts 8:30-32	31 Pray through these verses again. What else is the Lord speaking to you regarding this passage? Pray that the Lord will rise up more harvest workers to come into a ripe field.
