DISCUSSION QUESTIONS



1. Luke 14:11 says, "For all those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted." Basically, the first will be last and the last will be first. Do you usually want to be first or last? How can being last help you be humble?
2. The prince of pride says he loves the spotlight. Because he was so concerned with himself and his own image, he was really mean to his helper Ludacris. Why do you think it's hard to be loving to others when we are too busy loving ourselves?
3. Before Becky was hit with the ego booster ray, she was more concerned with helping others and the love of math than being the captain of the team. How did pride change her attitude and the way she treated her friend?
4. Becky wasn't showing respect to her friends or her teacher when she was full of pride. Why do you think pride makes us treat others poorly?
5. Bibleman said that when we ask forgiveness, we show humility. Is it hard for you to ask forgiveness when you've messed up?
6. Bibleman quotes Philippians 2:3-4. Look up and read this verse with your family. How can putting others before yourself help you practice humility? What are some ways you can "value others above yourself?"
7. Did you notice that the Bible team defeated the Prince of Pride and Ludacris by using Scripture? How do you think knowing and memorizing what the Bible says can help you beat sin?

CALL TO ACTION



Philippians 2 tells us that we should be humble just like Jesus was humble when He chose to die on the cross for our sins, even though he was GOD! If the God of the universe can put others before Himself, we should be encouraged to do the same. This week spend some time memorizing Philippians 2:3-4. Remember that when we put Scripture in our hearts, we do what it says! Throughout the week, practice "being last" by helping and caring for other people in your family before yourself. When we show humility, we become more and more like Jesus.
