DISCUSSION QUESTIONS



1. At the beginning of the episode, Ryan insisted that he didn't need any back up or help in the training simulator...but then he got "attacked" by a black panther! Why do you think he was so set on working alone? Do you prefer to work on your own or lean on others when things are hard?
2. Granny was so upset that she didn't earn first place that she turned evil! Sometimes it's hard when we don't get what we want, or others beat us out at something. How do you think Granny should have responded to winning second place in the hot sauce contest?
3. Ryan wasn't being very respectful when he first brought his mom to F.R.E.E.D.O.M. How do you think he could have treated her the way God says we should treat our parents?
4. Ryan was a really good agent, but he was also really arrogant about his skills. Why do you think his bad attitude made working on a team difficult?
5. Ryan's mom, Deb, was really successful in the mission. What was different in the way she acted towards the team and the way Ryan acted?
6. At the end of the mission, Ryan thanked his mom for saving his life and helping him. Why is it important to be grateful to those who help us?
7. If Moses hadn't relied on his friends to help hold his hands up, they could have lost the battle! Who are some people in your life who you can lean on for help when things get hard?

CALL TO ACTION



At the end of the episode, Ryan said that he could be humble enough to admit when he needed help. The hosts of the show reminded us that no one can go through this life on their own, we all need each other! Read Ecclesiastes 4:7-12 with your family. Talk about some of the ways the verses show us that having more than one person is better than being alone.
