## Stuff You Need To Know

### Time Away Cards

If your teenager needs to leave at any time during the weekend we will require a time-away card for each student. This card MUST be signed by the parent. Students will not be allowed to leave Chi Alpha without parental permission. Students will be able to receive a time-away card on Thursday night or you can print one off at [www.firstwoodway.org/youth](http://www.firstwoodway.org/youth).

### Student Drivers

Students who drive will be able to drive themselves to their host homes on Friday. However, we will be asking all student drivers to put their keys in the host home's vehicle key bag. This will allow us to safely keep all vehicles from being opened, used, or driven without permission. Students will not be allowed to help transport other students during the weekend. Our host home families and volunteers will be providing all transportation. If a student needs to leave for a parent-approved event they will be given keys to drive themselves. On Sunday morning, students will drive their vehicles to the church for the end of Chi Alpha.

### Cell Phones and Electronics

Cell phones will be allowed to be brought, but we will be asking students to place them in a basket during our six different Bible study sessions. We also reserve the right to take phones that are being improperly used during the weekend. We discourage any other electronic devices from being brought to Chi Alpha.

## FAQ's

### **Q. My student has a basketball game on Thursday night and won't make it to the kick-off. How do we find out their host home?**

A. We hate they will miss the kick-off. To find out their host home, they can ask a friend to find out and tell them or you can [email here](#) and ask. Or call the church office (Friday 8:00-3:00) 254.772.9696.

### **Q. We will miss the kick-off. Can we have a friend pick up our sweatshirt?**

A. This is discouraged and here is why... more sweatshirts get lost this way. Youth Staff will visit every house over the weekend AND they will have sweatshirts with them. The best thing to do is tell your student to ask the first Youth Staff person that visits their house for a sweatshirt! We will make sure all students receive it over the weekend.

### **Q. I have 4 kids attending Chi Alpha, 2 of them have a conflict on Thursday night. Can I get their sibling to pick up their sweatshirt and find out their host home?**

A. Absolutely! It makes it easy for people living at the same residence.

### **Q. My student has a soccer game on Saturday morning. What do I need to do?**

A. [Print off a time away card](#), complete it and take it with you to the host home. Details for pick up and dropping off can be coordinated through the host home.

### **Q. What time is Chi Alpha done on Sunday?**

A. We will be done after the 2nd hour worship service or around noon. Students can be picked up from the worship center. Their stuff will be in the Venue so be sure and pick that up on your way home!
