### How to Make Your GoodTimers’ Reservations

1. Go to **First Woodway’s weekly email**, and read the article about the upcoming meeting, click on the “Online” link in the GoodTimers’ article. This will take you to a reservation form where you will enter your name, the number of reservations that you submit, and then it will take you to the payment screen where you can enter your debit/credit card information. You will be given a confirmation # that your reservations have been confirmed. **Note:** Only click the “Submit” button one time and wait momentarily for your confirmation to show up.
2. A second way is to go to the **church website** for First Woodway Senior Adults. Here is the website: [firstwoodway.org/senior-adult](http://firstwoodway.org/senior-adult). This will take you to the Senior Adult information and click on “online” icon in the article to make your reservations.
3. Come by in person to the church office and someone will help you make and pay for your reservations by cash, check, debit or credit card.
4. If all else fails, you can call the church office (254-772-9696) and someone will take your reservations and payment information over the phone and confirm your reservations.
